In partnership with local Canberra Soccer Club O'Connor Knights, iDiC, Toll, Motivate Football Academy and Oxide, Kirra Services has established an initiative collecting football boots and other sporting equipment to send to remote aboriginal communities.

The initiative is all about helping kids to stay active and create opportunities for young people and rising sporting talent in aboriginal communities.

Since 2022 we have collected and transported 9 tonnes of soccer boots, uniforms, balls and jerseys to remote communities in need.
